Entry details and deadline

Please take a photo of your artwork and send it, along with a copy of this form to projects@crowthorne-pc.gov.uk by Wednesday 4th May for initial judging. Ensure the photo is a good, clear representation of your work. The high-resolution photo should be about 1MB in size. Please do not send files greater than 3MB.

Exhibiting

Shortlisted artists will be asked to bring their work to the parish office on 10-12th May for further judging along with a printed copy of the application form. Later, artwork will need to be collected from the parish office, or at the library if your piece is selected for exhibition.

Hanging

If your piece is chosen for exhibiting it must have horizontal hanging strings, wires, D-rings or similar fitted to take the weight. Pictures without this might not be displayed.
