Please take a photo of your artwork and send it, along with a copy of this form to [projects@crowthorne-pc.gov.uk](mailto:projects@crowthorne-pc.gov.uk) by Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May for initial judging. Ensure the photo is a good, clear representation of your work. The high-resolution photo should be about 1MB in size. Please do not send files greater than 3MB.

## **Exhibiting**

Shortlisted artists will be asked to bring their labelled work, along with a printed copy of the application form, to the parish office on 10-12<sup>th</sup> May for further judging. Later, artwork will need to be collected from the parish office, or at the library if your piece is selected for exhibition. If your piece is chosen for exhibiting, we will work with you to ensure that it is appropriately displayed.

## **Prizes**

In addition to artwork being publicly exhibited, winners and their prizes will be announced at the exhibition opening. Prizes have kindly been donated by Daler-Rowney, a manufacturer of quality art materials for more than 230 years.
