## Entry details and deadline

Please take a photo of your artwork and send it, along with a copy of this form to [projects@crowthorne-pc.gov.uk](mailto:projects@crowthorne-pc.gov.uk) by Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> May for initial judging. Make sure the photo is a good, clear representation of your work. The high-resolution photo should be about 1MB in size. Please do not send files greater than 3MB.

## Exhibiting

Judges will select the art that they would like to see. Artists will be asked to bring their work, along with a printed copy of the application form, to the parish office on 10-12<sup>th</sup> May. Judges will then decide which pieces of art will be displayed in the exhibition.

## Hanging

If your piece is chosen for exhibiting it must look its best. Ideally, it should be framed with a strong wire or string on the back. Or, you could use a mount or make a cardboard frame.
